

℣ Psalm 30 (29): 2




I will praise you, Lord, for you have res - cued me.

℣ Psalm 30 (29): 2, 4, 5-6, 11-13.




1. I will extol you, Lord, for you have raised me up, and have not let my enemies re - joice over me.
