
John 2: 7-8




Fill the jars with wa - ter, and bring some to the mas - ter of the feast.

John 2: 9-11; Psalm 66 (65): 1-3, 4-5, 6, 8. T. 8G; additional music: BMP




1. When the master of the feast tasted the water that had be - come wine,
