

They ate, and they were fully satisfied.

℣ *Psalm 78 (77): 29-30. 1, 3-4a. 4b. 23-24. 25, 27.*



 5. Man ate the bread of angels He sent them a bun-dance of food;



 5. He rained down flesh upon them like dust,




1. while the food was still in their mouths. ℣
